Dear Parent/Carer

Year 9 German trip to Rhineland - 1 to 5 July 2024

I am delighted to be able to offer your child/ward the opportunity to take part in the Year 9 German trip to the Rhineland next summer. The tour, arranged through Select School Tours, will take place during Activities Week from 1 - 5 July 2024. Departing West Kirby in the early hours of Monday morning, we will travel by executive coach to Boppard, a beautiful historical town in an area forming part of a UNESCO world heritage site on the river Rhine. We will be staying for four nights on a full-board basis at the riverside Hotel Rheinlust, 5 minutes from the centre of Boppard.

The tour will comprise several visits to local sites of interest, culminating in an excursion on the final day to Phantasialand, one of Germany's principal theme parks. During the tour, students will have the opportunity to practise their spoken German and to gain a better understanding of the country's culture, customs and traditions.

The cost of the trip is £570. This includes transport, insurance, full board whilst at the hotel and entrance fees to the various sites on the programme.

PROGRAMME

The provisional programme is as follows:

Monday 1 July 2024	Depart WKGS. Travel by coach to Dover. Dover to Calais ferry. Board coach and travel overland to Germany, arriving at Hotel Rheinlust in Boppard in time for evening meal.
Tuesday 2 July 2024	Breakfast followed by morning exploring Boppard. Rhineland cruise to St Goarshausen before embarking coach to Rüdesheim, a charming Rhineland town. Visit Siegfrieds Mechanisches Musikkabinet, a small museum of the most wonderful mechanical musical instruments, followed by free time in Rüdesheim before returning to hotel for evening meal. Evening programme.
Wednesday 3 July 2024	Breakfast followed by tour of the Marksburg , a medieval castle built to protect the citizens of Braubach and remaining untouched by potential invaders. Drive to Koblenz for remainder of afternoon. Free time to explore main sites of Koblenz , a city which is situated at the point where the Rhine and the Moselle meet, souvenir shopping before returning to hotel for evening meal. Evening programme.
Thursday 4 July 2024	Breakfast followed by full day visit to Phantasialand . Return to hotel for evening meal. Evening programme and packing for early departure.
Friday 5 July 2024	Breakfast followed by early departure. Board coach for departure to Calais. Calais to Dover ferry. Coach from Dover to West Kirby, arriving late evening.

INSURANCE

Students will be covered by the school's travel insurance policy. If your child/ward has a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) that will still be in date during the trip, they will be able to use this. If they do not, you will need to apply for Global Health Insurance Card on the NHS website. If you are reading the electronic version of this letter, you will find the address on the following link:

We have an extensive insurance policy but these cards allow for quick and easy access to healthcare in the unfortunate event it becomes necessary.

EUROPEAN VISA WAIVER (ETIAS)

The European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS) is a visa waiver system which will come into effect in 2024. All UK visitors to Germany will, therefore, need to complete the ETIAS online application and obtain an approved ETIAS visa waiver before entering the country, unless they are travelling on a passport from a Schengen area country. Currently, no charge is made for minors applying for the ETIAS visa waiver. More details will be sent to parents once the system has been fully introduced. The visa waiver will be processed quickly online for most applicants, provided that they are travelling on a passport from an eligible country. UK passport holders should not have spent more than 90 days in the previous 180 days in a Schengen area country.

PAYMENTS

Deposit

A deposit of £100 is required by Select School Tours and I would ask you to ensure that this is paid by Friday 22^{nd} September. Payments should be made via Scopay. You should also use Scopay to confirm your consent. Please ensure you provide any appropriate additional information on the electronic consent form when paying online. Please note that numbers for this trip are limited to 40 students.

2nd Payment

A second deposit of £150 will then be required by Friday 10th November 2023.

Payment of Balance

The final payment of £320 must be received by Friday 22nd March 2024.

Please also complete the attached slip giving passport information and return it to your child's/ward's German teacher once payment of the deposit has been made. Please ensure that the passport being used for travel is valid for at least 3 months after the day we leave Germany; it should therefore be valid until at least 5 October 2024.

Please be aware that withdrawing from the trip after a place is confirmed will mean that deposits cannot be returned, and further payments may need to be made. We do expect high demand for places so please adhere to the deadlines given.
