Tutors have asked that we make parents/carers aware that:

- Parents/Carers will receive an invoice at the beginning of each term from the tutor which should be paid within 21 days from date of invoice. Tuition will not be continued after this time.
 The tutor reserves the right not to commence or to discontinue lessons due to non-payment of fees, lack of progress or poor attendance.
- Six weeks written notice is required for cessation of lessons payment is required for this period.
- Payment should be made directly to the tutor, by cash, cheque or internet transfer if available (see invoice for details).
- The tutor will be available for a minimum of 30 lessons per academic year, averaging at least 10 per term where possible.
- The tutor will determine the type of lesson appropriate to the pupil.
- Any shortfall in the number of lessons available will be made up in the previous or ensuing term. If this is not possible, the tutor will refund the parent/carer in full for any lessons not delivered.
- Every effort will be made to avoid examination sessions and School trips, but it is the responsibility of the pupil to inform the tutor in advance of any known absences (e.g. holidays or medical appointments).
- It is the responsibility of the pupil to attend lessons punctually and at the correct time each week. (Timetables from tutors are displayed outside G6).

Money will not be refunded for forgetfulness

- A discretionary remissions policy will operate at the school. Please write to the Headteacher in confidence before completing the contract with the tutor.
- It is the responsibility of the pupils to practise (10-20 minutes at least three times a week longer and more frequently for advanced pupils) and prepare any theory work set.
- Pupils should bring their own instrument to School for tuition (except voice, piano, keyboard and percussion). Instruments should be clearly labelled on the outside of the case and insured as the school accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
