Messages from the Headteacher:

Parent/Carer Survey

Thank you to all parents/carers of our students who took the time to complete the survey giving us feedback on current parent/carer views of our provision. We were delighted to receive 736 responses with excellent levels of engagement from all year groups.

Responses were overwhelmingly positive with 95% of parents/carers reporting that they felt their child/ward was doing well at the school and that the school makes sure students are well behaved, with 99% of parents/carers reporting that their child/ward feels safe.

95% of parents/carers felt that we have high expectations for our students and 96% felt that there is a good range of subjects available to our students.

We recognise that parents/carers would like us to consider how we communicate with them about how students are doing, and what students are studying during the year, as these areas scored a little lower (78% satisfaction for how students are doing and 70% satisfaction for what students will learn).

We will now make these items a priority for development and will be using the newsletter and other school systems for communicating these aspects of school life more clearly.

Sixth Form Open Evening

We are looking forward to hosting our Sixth Form Open Evening on Wednesday 22 November from 6 – 8pm. This evening is designed to be an opportunity for existing and prospective students to gain a further insight into the courses on offer,

what they involve and the wider opportunities available by joining the WKGS Sixth Form.

Prior to the Open Evening, our current Year 11 students will also take part in a Sixth Form Taster Day where they will have the opportunity to try 4 different subjects as well as spend time using the Sixth Form facilities and taking part in a study skills session.

Silver Award

Important information for parents of students interesting in registering for Silver DofE. We have had 60 expressions of interest in completing the Silver award. Please note that the dates of the **compulsory expeditions** next year are as follows:-

Saturday March 16th - Silver training day Saturday April 27th - Sunday April 28th - Practice weekend (1 night) Friday 28th June - Sunday 30th June - Expedition (2 nights)

For Silver, the requirement is 6 months of volunteering and 6 months of either skills or physical (the other can be just 3 months). Activities for these sections can be backdated by 2 months so the sooner we can get students registered, the better.

I will ask again next week for definite names/numbers of those who want to sign up and then issue payment schedule on Scopay.

Bronze Award

Deposits (£80) will need to be paid by Friday November 24th to secure a place.

Reminder that the first payment of £60 was due on 1 November. There are still some payments missing. The next instalment is due in January and the final payment must be made by 31 March 2024.

Places Available at West Kirby Grammar School for Year 7 Entry in January 2024

There are a small number of places available for students to join WKGS in Year 7 in January 2024.

If you have any friends or family with a daughter who is in Year 7 this September, and who might be interested in transferring to WKGS, we would be grateful if you can make them aware of this opportunity.

In all instances, applications are to be made online at <u>Apply for a transfer to a Wirral primary or secondary school</u> or complete an <u>'In Year Transfer for Secondary aged children' form</u> and e-mail to: <u>schooladmissions@wirral.gov.uk</u> The application will then be forwarded to ourselves.

To assist us with tracking the applications it would be helpful if parents/carers can complete our <u>online form</u> so that we can track the applications with the Local Authority.

The next assessment date is on November 29th and we will contact parents/carers to confirm the time and arrangements for the assessment.

Assessments papers are National Curriculum based in both Mathematics and English and a verbal reasoning paper.
