Psychology tour to London 28th November – 29th November 2023

The Psychology department is pleased to offer our bi-annual school tour to London to support our curriculum plans for Psychology students and to enhance learning experiences within the school.

The key details about the planned trip are:

- 2 days and 1 night. Departs on Tuesday 28th November 2023 & returns on Wednesday 29th November 2023
- The provisional cost is £265.00 per pupil (this is a voluntary contribution, but please note that if insufficient contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled).
- The price includes travel to and from London by coach, departing from and returning to West Kirby Grammar School. The coach will remain with us whilst we are in London to take us to and from all venues.
- Bed and breakfast accommodation at YHA Thameside, London.
- The group size will be approximately 50 students plus 4 staff members.

The suggested itinerary for the trip includes:

- Hypnosis session and workshop
- Buffet meal with soft drink at Pizza Hut
- Jack the Ripper Walking Tour
- Entrance to London Eye
- Facilitated tour & discussion at Freud Museum
- Entrance to London Dungeon

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. To secure a place for your child/ward, a non-refundable deposit of £75.00 is required by **Tuesday 5 September 2023**. Please pay online and give consent, if appropriate, by using the online payment system (if this is likely to cause any financial difficulties, please contact Mr S Clarke, Headteacher, in confidence by email to office@wkgs.net). Please ensure you provide any appropriate additional information on the electronic consent form when paying online.
