A Level Physics in Action, King's House Conference Centre, Manchester Tuesday 21 November 2023

Year 12 and 13 students who are studying Physics are invited to take part in a trip to 'Physics in Action' which is coming to Manchester on Tuesday 21 November.

The 'Physics in Action' event is an A level study experience which will feature five sessions of engaging and up-to-date physics presented by experts in their fields. These inspiring sessions are designed to complement the KS5 curriculum, taking students from classroom physics to cutting-edge-research and real-world applications. There will also be a special session on examination success which will give the students hints and tips to excel.

The cost of the trip is £31 which covers the entrance costs and contributes to the cost of transport to and from school. The cost of the transport has been subsidised by a grant from The Ogden Trust. There is limited availability for this trip, so places will be issued on a first come first served basis. If you would like your child/ward to attend, please pay online by Friday 29 September and give consent, if appropriate, by using the online payment system (if this is likely to cause any financial difficulties, please contact Mr S Clarke, Headteacher, in confidence by email to office@wkgs.net). Please ensure you provide any appropriate additional information on the electronic consent form when paying online.

We will leave school at 8.30am and travel to and from school by coach, returning for 4pm. Your child/ward will need to bring a packed lunch (if your child/ward is entitled to free school meals a 'grab bag' can be ordered the day before the trip from the canteen for collection from 8am on the day of the trip. 'Grab-bags' may also be ordered to purchase).
