They will make visits to exhibitions and galleries which are appropriate to their theme. They will be expected to develop work which will be inspired by their 2000-3000 word essay. This is a personal investigative project and will require resilience and independence of thought. They will be required to source their own resources e.g. fabrics, trimmings and embellishment for their final piece.</p> <p>Students will work in a sketchbook for their personal essay and on a mount board for preparation of development work.</p> <p>They will present their work in appropriate manner thinking how it would be exhibited and viewed in a gallery space</p> |
